To mark our 30th anniversary, we are offering a brand new free sewing pattern so you can celebrate with us! The possibilities are endless, both in the choice and use of fabrics. Pennant banners can be used as an eco-friendly birthday party or children's room decorations (hint: this project is ideal to use up your scraps).

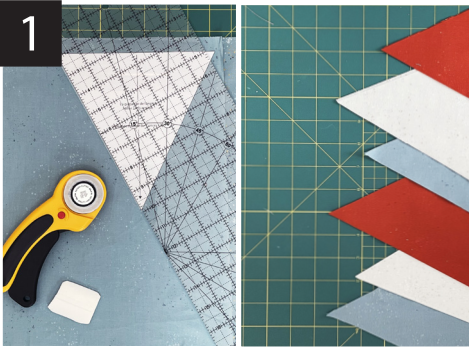
## MATERIALS

20 cm of quilting cotton to make 3 pennants

Twill tape 25mm to make the garland. The quantity depends on the desired length.

(for the project shown, we used 2.5 m)

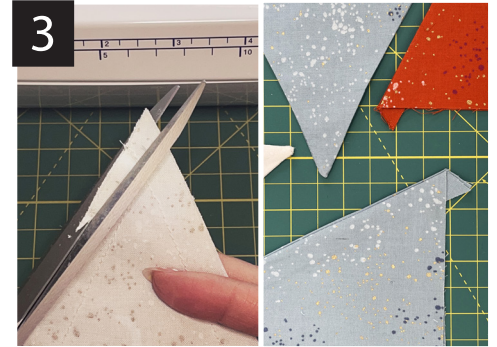
## STEPS



1- Cut the quantity of pennants according the desired banner length. Always cut 2 triangles of the same fabric design per finished pennant.



2- Place two triangles right sides together and sew both sides together to create the tip.



3- Cut off the corner and turn the pennant over. Iron it to make sure it is flat.



4- Once all the pennants are made, place them side by side on the twill tape, fold over and sew 2 mm from the edge of the tape to secure them.
